**CCCSBH mission is: Improving financial stability through guidance and education.
Maintaining safe and affordable housing is key to improving financial stability**

In 2024, we provided counseling for 405 households including individuals who are homeless, families renting or hoping to rent, families wanting to buy a home, families wanting to prevent mortgage default and keep their homes, and financial management counseling.

We provided homebuyer education, rental education, and financial education classes for 1,522 individuals. We returned \$552,933.16 back to the community in 2024.

76.9% are under 50% of Area Median Income
65.1% are under 30% of Area Median Income

41.4% are White
33% are Native American
25.6% are Other Races

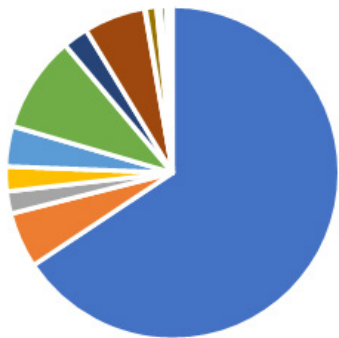
